WHY AN OUTDOOR/EXPERIENTIAL APPROACH FOR LEARNING ABOUT LEADERSHIP?

Leading people is an activity which draws upon not only ones cognitive competencies, but also upon a wide range of behavioral, interactive and affective competencies. Learning to become a more effective leader consequently must involve more than cognitive inputs only: good concepts are helpful but not enough.

Self-awareness has been shown to be a key element in becoming a more effective leader – what is my typical style? What effect does this have on others?

Experiential/Outdoor activities force participants to not only think but also to act. Participants are no longer observing from the sidelines, they are actively involved in the learning process. In action, the activities quickly reveal participants' typical approaches to tasks, interacting with others, and style of leading a team.

Feedback on observed behavior enhances participants' self-awareness of their own strengths and weaknesses as a leader and team member and is the first step towards actual behavioral change to become more effective.

During and following the activities our facilitators work as coaches to help participants become more aware of their actions and the effect they have on others, to narrow the gap between intention and effect.
